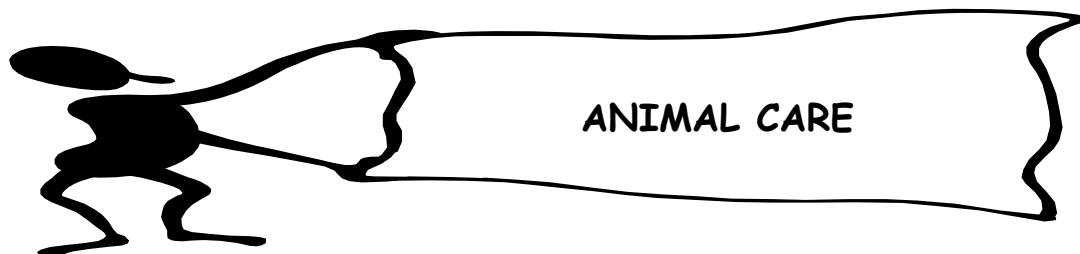

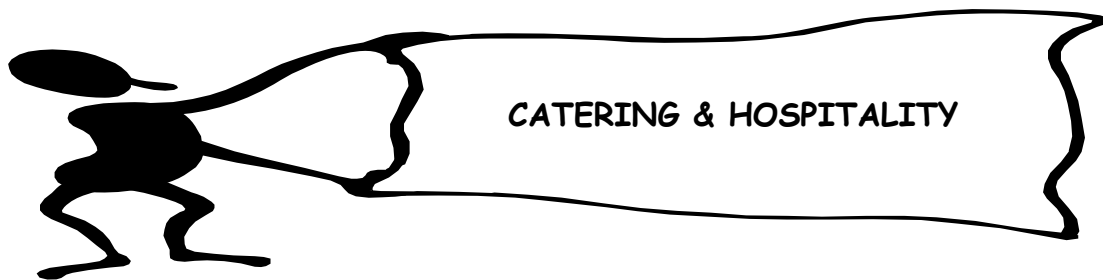

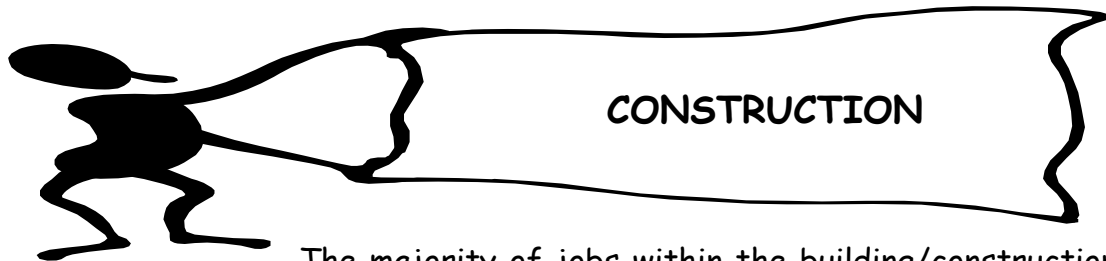

Dry lining is all about turning empty buildings into finished spaces. It is a construction term used by industry professionals to refer to a system of lightweight sheets (plasterboard) fixed to metal framework to form walls and ceilings within buildings. In fact, dry lining applies generally to the use of plasterboard to replace traditional internal construction methods such as bricks or blocks that then require a smooth finish.

The sort of skills that Astins Apprentice will develop in dry lining includes reading construction drawings and plans, setting out the position of internal walls, constructing and finishing internal walls and ceilings and working within a professional construction team. You will train to NVQ Level 2 in dry lining at the institute. Site work will be at one of the Astins Projects (large commercial construction sites); the apprentices will be working as part of a team under the watchful eye of one of Astins High trained mentors. The initial training will be in 12 weeks in 3 blocks, it will take up to two years to achieve NVQ Level 2 in dry lining.
